



## Rules and regulations.

- \* By making a reservation with us, you are agreeing to the rules and regulations below entirely. We have the right to welcome or refuse anyone. If you are asked to leave the premises, you will not be refunded for your stay.
- \* All adults, including guests staying on premises (age 18 and older) must provide proof of valid state issued driver's license or ID card. No exceptions. If you have guests visiting you during park hours you must inform us ahead of time and provide their names and vehicle information.
- \* 6 campers are allowed per campsite maximum (including children). Daily/weekly rates include 3 adults (aged 18 and older). Additional adults (aged 18 and older) are \$20 per night.
- \* Check-in and Check-out. Weekday check-in is between 5pm and 8pm. Weekend check-in is from 9am – 8pm. If you have a special check-in requirement outside of these times let us know ahead of time and we can attempt to coordinate with you.
- \* We take pride in our RV park and our facilities, please clean up after yourself after using our restroom, showers, and outdoor pavilion. Leave your campsite clean and orderly just like you found it, leave nothing behind but the great memories of your stay!
- \* We want you to enjoy your stay, however public intoxication, illegal drugs, profane language, and disorderly conduct is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated while on this property. This is for your safety and ours. There are no exceptions. Your guests and your children are your responsibility. All guests of yours and children must agree to the park rules or they will be asked to leave.

- \* If you smoke, please dispose of cigarette/cigar butts properly. Do not throw them on our grounds or dispose of them improperly.
- \* For the safety of everyone, children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult while on the property at all times. This includes the rest rooms, outdoor pavilion, or while in your RV/travel trailer.
- \* We love pets and their humans, but for the safety of all, pets must always be on a leash and accompanied by their owner (an adult) when outside of an RV/travel trailer, with no exceptions. Pets are not to be tied up or left in pet carriers, cages, kennels, or cars or left unattended outside of an RV at any time, no exceptions. If your pets are disturbing the peace (i.e., barking, crying, growling, or acting aggressive) you will be asked to leave with no exceptions. Pet's poop, we know! Feel free to walk your pet to do its business, but please pick up your pet waste and dispose of it properly. Pet waste left on our grounds is prohibited, with no exceptions. If you do not pick up your pet waste, you will be asked to leave. Pets are not allowed in the restrooms. We do not allow categorically aggressive dogs period. Pit Bulls, Rottweilers, German Shepherds, and Dobermans are not allowed on property.
- \* Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am. We try to offer all our guests a quiet and peaceful experience. Loud music and loud outdoor televisions are prohibited. Loud vehicles, motorcycles or loud pets (barking dogs) are prohibited, no exceptions.
- \* You are allowed two vehicles other than your RV while on property. We are a small park and do not have a significant amount of room for parking when we are full. If you require additional parking, please coordinate with us for exceptions ahead of time.
- \* The speed limit at the RV park is 5 miles per hour. No exceptions. Do not drive or park on the grass unless directed or approval is granted.
- \* ATV's, side by sides or dirt bikes are not allowed to be ridden on property. If you bring an ATV, side by side, or dirt bike on property, you must leave it on the trailer.
- \* No mechanical repair of vehicles, boats, ATVs, motorcycles, etc. is allowed on property of the RV park.

- \* A waste dumpster is available for guest use, please bag your waste by placing it in a plastic trash bag and ensuring the bag is properly secured and tied closed before placing it in the dumpster. Household trash only is allowed in the dumpster.
- \* Use RV toilet paper only in our sewer system. Do not flush “flushable” wipes, baby wipes, or feminine products of any kind down our sewer or restroom toilets.
- \* The use of firearms or weapons of any kind are not allowed while on the property. Fireworks are also strictly prohibited.
- \* Our RV park is monitored 24x7 with closed caption audio and video cameras outdoors for your safety and our safety. If you or anyone in your party is found tampering with any video cameras onsite, you will be asked to leave without refund, no exceptions.
- \* We have a functional hobby farm bordering the RV park. Please enjoy viewing the animals! We hope you will love watching them as much as we do! Under no circumstances are you allowed to pet, feed, or touch the animals. Under no circumstances are you allowed to climb on, hang on, or throw anything at or over the animal fence. Do not walk your pets anywhere near the animal fence bordering the RV park. If you have questions about this let us know and we will provide details.
